Artists Loading Zones

Please take look at the 2018 Ocala Arts Festival Map, find your booth number and look at the legend to find your assigned time. You must come in during your assigned time due to the road closure procedures scheduled by the City of Ocala.

You may park by your booth to unload, but then please move your vehicle to a parking space around the downtown. We have 3 paved parking lots available for you across from the Post Office at 400 SW 1st Ave, Ocala, FL 34478. You may park your cars, trucks and trailers in these lots.

Artists who arrive after 6:30pm Friday must wait until Saturday at 6:00am to set up. All artists must be ready by 9am Saturday. Judging begins at 9am.

Artist Check-in location is **420 SE 1st Ave, Ocala, FL 34471**.

The address for City Hall and Citizens' Circle is 110 SE Watula Ave, Ocala, FL 34471.

* **5:30pm- 7pm Collector's Circle (CC) Preview Party** ~ The Preview Party is where CC members get a first peek to view and, possibly, buy artwork as they walk the festival grounds. Members who purchase artwork will give the artists a CC Card to display next to the purchased artwork which will only be picked up after judging has taken place.

General Information

Booth Sitting If you need to take a bathroom break, please call your **FAFO Artist Liaison** whose number will be in your Artist Packet. S/he will watch your booth.

Parking
The City of Ocala has a free parking garage — for cars only — located at 504 SE Broadway St, Ocala, FL 34471. You may also find parking around the downtown area or there are 3 paved parking lots available for you across from the Post Office at 400 SW 1st Ave, Ocala, FL 34478. You can park your cars, trucks and trailers here. Please refer to the map for road closures.
RV, Trailers and Overnight Parking Artists may park on SW 4th Street between SE Magnolia Ext. and SW 1st Ave. This area will have an ADA portable toilet and wash station.

*Please have your vehicles out of the event zone and parked by 9:00am on Saturday and by 9:30am Sunday. Do not block streets nor park in the handicap parking areas without a permit.

Judging Judging will promptly begin on **Saturday 9AM**.
You must be in your booth and have your Exhibitor Display Card visible. This card will be in the Artist Packet you receive when you check in on Friday. Each judge will place a dot on your Exhibitor Display Card to indicate that your work has been viewed. If you do not have 2 dots by **4:30pm**, please notify your FAFO Liaison. All judging will take place inside your booth.

Awards **The Artist's Dinner** is on Saturday at 6:30pm. The winners will be announced at the **Artist Award's Ceremony** at 7:00pm. Winners will receive their ribbons that evening. Winners' checks will be distributed on Sunday.

Sales Tax Ocala, Marion County sales tax is 7%

Security & Other Requirements

The grounds will be secured with Ocala Police Officers during the entire festival (including all night), but your art is your own responsibility. City ordinance prohibits fireworks and pets. To aid our security, please try to stay out of the show area on Saturday night.

2. After receiving your Artist Packet, please park next to your booth and unload. Then quickly move your car to an artist's parking area.
 - **RV and overnight parking on Saturday & Sunday on SW 4th Street between SE Magnolia Ext. and SW 1st Ave.** This area will have an ADA portable toilet and wash station. You must be out of the parking lot by Monday at 8am.
 - You may park cars in the parking garage and non-permit spaces around downtown.
